Master's thesis

The topic of the Master's thesis must derive from core studies and must bear reference to a course in the Master's subjects.

Exchange

An exchange semester is ruled out in the first semester of the Master's Level, irrespective of whether studies were started in the Autumn or Spring Semester.

Beginning of the Master's Programme

Students with a degree from the University of St.Gallen can start the Master's Programme in an Autumn Semester or Spring Semester. Students with a degree from another university can start the Master's Programme in an Autumn Semester only (Pursuant to Art. 9 of the Admission Regulations for the Business Administration Master's Programmes MAccFin, MUG, MSC and MBI).

Transition provisions

The new structure of contextual studies will be introduced for all students as from Autumn Semester 2018. Students who have not completed their studies under the old course regulations by the end of Spring Semester 2018 will be converted to the 2018 Regulations. The Dean of Studies shall issue detailed provisions for the conversion of work done by students in contextual studies before Autumn Semester 2018.
